MINISTRY REPORT (May to November 2022)

Children Ministry~ As mentioned in my last prayer letter, we were praying and planning for the come back of of VBS. For two years we were not given the chance by our government to do it because of big crowds we had in the past.

We prayed for God's will on our VBS, and the Lord led us to a different path. We were not able to do the same but the Lord privileged us last August in to weeks in several locations over 1500 children. **And** for two months our Children Ministry grew to 800 children and now in this month of November in my surprise during our regular Pastor's meeting we tallied our numbers and we are now ministering to over 1200 Children in 49 centers in a weekly basis.



Evangelism, Discipleship and Church Planting

For the past six months of ministries. The Lord gave us so many opportunity to share the glorious gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Many times of it were during church services, passing out gospel tracts and through group Bible studies in the homes of our church folks.

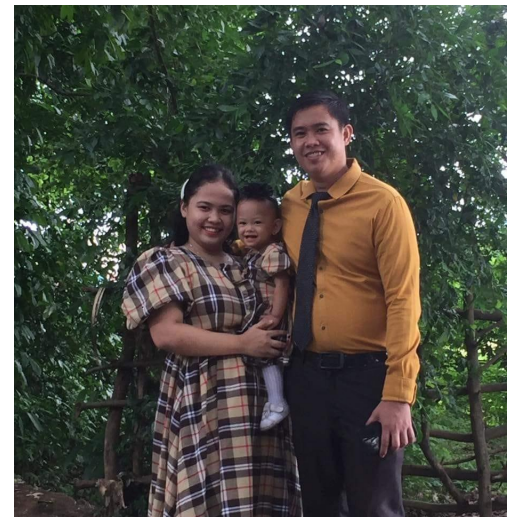

Last Month of August we are so privilege to have a “Commission Ceremony” for him at the end of our SBI Musical Presentation. We are so glad to have Pastor Rickey and Pastor Stan visited us and joined to pray over Brother Isagani as he start his new mission work. Currently He has already baptized new members and averaging 20 people every church services.

We are also blessed to have Brother Ralph and Sis. Kenny Ann to be back with us. They were away from us for 3 years and planted a church. Now they started a new mission work in the vilage of “Siling Matanda”. We are praying that early next year they will start having church services.
