I would like to share to you the encouragement she has been to us. Sis. Nemia, although with a loss of hearing and poor eyesight due to sickness and old age, she was the one of the most consistent attendee to our Sunday Services and most especially to our Prayer Meetings. She has never missed any services, except when the day had brought heavy rains. She has to go down a very long stairs and down a cemented road to be able to come to church so when heavy rain pours we know she cannot be with us. She told us during our thanksgiving on how she cannot understand how and why she had to slowly lose her hearing and eyesight, but she said that she was always thankful to God that she never complained why it came to her. She has been a very good example to us and just by hearing her say those words she got us all in tears. May we ask for your help in prayers that you help us pray for her strength and good health as according to her, she has more to give to the Lord. Our thanksgiving was filled with tears and laughter and a heartfelt thanksgiving. We also had you to thank for, for your continuous prayers and support. Within this month, we also started a Good News Class at Nangalisan, we had to do it in the afternoon because it was too hot, we have to walk along the riverbanks to get to them and had to wait for the kids to come home from the river, it was such a rewarding sight when we get to see how focused they were in learning. Last Saturday of the month, we went to Alabok, up the mountains to celebrate another fruitful year to one of the churches we are supporting, it was really fascinating on how God brought His people together even in the mountains where houses are far from the church.

In the month of February, we started sharing the Gospel to the young people mostly High Schoolers, who are staying in the nearby boarding houses. And we thank God that they were able to join the Tuesday night fellowship. This month has been fruitful to us, for we were able to add two more missionaries to whom we are supporting, Ptr. Bernardo Arimas and Ptr. Lizardo Valeros. We thank God that we were still able to support more local missionaries and our brethren here have loved doing so. At the end of this month, we started a new project; we had roofed the remaining space at the back of the church. It has been the children's playground so we had it roofed so that they can play there rain or shine. Please do pray for the needs of this project.

March was just a somewhat repeat of our February, we were not able to go out for we are the ones working on our project, for we do not have enough funds to pay for outside workers. We are so thankful to one of our brethren here who has dedicated his days in working with us together with his son. Sadly, we have to put it on hold for we have used all of our funds, but we are still thankful that we had at least roofed the children's play area. Please do help us pray for God's providence that we may be able to finish our project. With the project being on hold, we were able to go back to soul winning and Good News Classes by the grace of God. We were also able to attend one of the Churches' anniversary here in our town, the Pasacla Baptist Church. Within

this month two babies have been dedicated to God by their parents. We are having lots of kids inside the church and we pray that these kids will grow up fearing God and honoring His words.

My family and I, by the grace of God, we are all doing fine. Do pray for us, most especially our health, old age has been taking a toll on my body and it's a bit hard to adjust. But I do believe that through God's grace we are still able to do things for God's glory.
