Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thank you so much for your prayers and your continued support as your missionaries to Baguio City, Philippines. The Lord is really working on our patience as we wait for papers to be processed so we can finally go to the Philippines.

A little bit of an update about us, last month, we were able to send out our medical examination and vaccination records to USCIS for our green card application to continue. Since then, we haven't heard back from USCIS. It is making us a little bit nervous because when I try to track our application process, it still looks like they haven't seen our medical and vaccination records. According to USPS, they have delivered the package and someone was able to receive our package and sign. We will try to get an update from USCIS this month and ask if they received our papers accordingly.

We also just sent and processed Amillia's passport since her name needed to be updated after our marriage. According to the Bureau of Consular Affairs, it would take 10-13 weeks before we receive her passport. We sent it last week and we are hoping and praying that we receive it as soon as possible. Please pray with us as we try our best to be patient and wait for a response back.

According to our estimate, it all seems to be lining up around **November/December** when we'll get an answer from USCIS for our green card application and also receive her passport from the Bureau of Consular Affairs. That's enough time for us to buy the plane ticket to fly to the Philippines in the last week of January which God already provided for a few months ago. Praise the Lord!

All we can do at this point is wait and leave it in God's hands. God already provided for the plane ticket so we are certain that He wants us to be in the Philippines. We know He has a purpose in all of this and we will trust in His perfect timing.
