Dear Beloved Pastor and loving friends in the ministry,

Greetings in the Mighty Precious Name of our only Saviour, Jesus Christ!

Thank you to all your prayers, love and support as our partners in the mission area here in the islands of Mindanao; from the provinces of Davao Region, Bukidnon and Misamis Occidental, Philippines.

I press toward the mark for the prize of the HIGH CALLING of God in Christ Jesus.
Philippians 3:14

Indeed, doing God's work is the noblest of all vocation, and the highest calling of all profession there is, as emphasized by God's Word; nothing above else that makes me so happy in doing this greatest job on earth, but to exclusively Glorify our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, all of these great work are possible because of God and you as our partners in bringing lives to Jesus Christ one step at a time in professing as their only Lord and personal Saviour.

We are now in the second quarter of this year's mission works; we have covered three (3) provinces in our street preaching, house to house evangelism, we have distributed more than fifteen thousand (15,000) gospel tracts in three (3) months, hundreds of souls got saved through Jesus Christ, thirty seven (37) new believers followed Jesus Christ in water baptism (Bukidnon and Davao Mission area), through your generosity, we fed three hundred (300) children in Bukidnon mission area, distributed more than two hundred (200) pairs of flip flops (special thanks to Pastor Jeff and Maam Michelle of Harvest Baptist Church, Elizabethton, TN), distributed more than seven hundred kilos (700kls) of used clothing to two hundred ten (210) families, visited to fourteen (14) mission churches and local missionary pastors, God added new mission area in, Lacolac, Baungon, Bukidnon, travelled and covered more than two thousand five hundred kilometers (3,500kms) for the last three months, and all of these are for the mark of the prize of the High Calling of God in Jesus Christ.

During our tour in the mission field for this quarter, the results are very overwhelming that humbles us in recognition of our God's mercy and provision; there are kids who walked ten (10) kilometers, some are event farther just to attend when they heard that there will be bible stories, fun and games intended just for the kids alone; the trail they hiked is not paved with concrete or a plain path on smooth grass, it is uphill, downhill, sharp and ragged rocks and stones on spill ways, not to mention the thick vegetation of the jungle along the way, where venomous snakes and wild boars are roaming. These episodes in kids' life who just want to know the story of Jesus Christ really melts my heart, I thought me and my team sacrificed a lot to travel long hours with a little sleep, but the kids suffered even more than we do, just to learn more about Christ and have fellowship with us.

After the bible stories, we have this one game about bible verses, kids who can recite at least ten (10) bible verse will receive a lollipop as big as a softball, the kids eyes were ablazed and their faces are glowing in awesomeness when they saw the biggest lollipop in their entire life; kids lined up and started to recite bible verses even in their own dialect in completing the required bible verses, and just to get the rarest prize they will receive in their childhood life, it is so encouraging to see, hear and witness that these kids are enjoying the fellowship in gathering for the cause of Jesus Christ, the joy and happiness is uncontainable and very contagious during the mission tours.





Regardless of the dangers on the road they are facing, the kids and their moms are so determined to attend, because of their interest about the Gospel, and as a reward, we serve them food, drinks, gave away flip flops and used clothing that we bring in as a gift also for the sacrifice they made for Christ.



I bring you all with me in all the mission work we are doing here, I feel all your prayers and loving support, especially to the lives that surrendered to Jesus Christ, that every time I and our team stands in the crowd to preach the Gospel of salvation, I am always fired up and enthusiastic to preach because of your prayers and loving support; in all these harvests of souls, as a member of the body of Christ, we all are functioning like a clock work, without the help of the other, the gears will not work, I do highly appreciate you all, specifically you Pastor, as the one who encourage all our brethren to love the mission work to every corner of the globe, I love you all.



Further, much more is needed to be done, that is why our "Missions Tribal Training Program" in equipping the Talaandig tribe as local missionaries for the native tribesmen is aggressively going on, for there are spiritual wars going on in our mission areas; witchcraft, idolatry, false doctrine teachings and local rebel groups (ISIS and NPA), and only the Name of Jesus Christ can topple down these enemies. The graduates of our training program will infiltrate the unreached areas in the heart of the jungles of our mission area, as of now, we have produced 14 local missionaries, and we are praying for more to surrender their lives in the ministry, the harvest is plenteous, but the laborers are few.

We are fervently praying that in God's time we will have a decent facility to house our students on this program (four(4) classrooms, library, dormitory and a fellowship hall), we are praying for \$78,000 to build the whole facility, from purchasing the lot and for the building facilities; the one (1) hectare land costs \$40,000, and the \$38,000 is for the building materials and labor.

When we stop to envision and plan how to glorify our God, how to magnify His ministry that God entrusted us; it is where we perish, fade, defeated and lost the function as part of the body of Christ. Let us give God a reason to pour us much blessings by being excited to do and support the ministry that He entrusted us, let us be part of the team that supports in all aspect in materializing the envisioned plan as to aggressively execute and implement God's plan, that Christ do not want that any should perish, but all must come to repentance and be grafted again into the true vine, that is Jesus Christ. Everything and all that we do here is for the glory and in the Name of Jesus Christ alone.

Third quarter of the year 2025 is unfolding, and much work needed to be done for God's glory; help us in prayer to sustain the needs for the fourteen (14) mission work that God gave us, each mission area needs \$300 a month to sustain the needs, it is not easy, but with God, nothing is impossible.
