UPDATES FOR AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER

I am truly filled with joy and excitement as I share another update on the wonderful things the Lord is doing through our ministry here in Cavite, Philippines. It's hard to believe how quickly the months have passed since we began our regular services last July—time truly flies when you're serving the Lord!

These past couple of months have been especially fruitful, particularly in our children's outreach ministry. We've witnessed steady growth in every children's center. What began with just 5 to 10 children has now grown to 10 to 20 children attending regularly. Praise God for this increase!

Our daily house-to-house gospel tract distribution and Bible studies have also been going well. We continue to meet families who are open and eager to hear God's Word. Currently, we have ten house churches where we hold weekly Bible studies with each family. We are praying that, by God's grace, each one will come to know and receive our Savior.

It fills my heart with gratitude and awe to see how the Lord is moving here in Cavite. What a blessing and a privilege it is to be used by God—even though we are unworthy, He still chooses to give us opportunities to serve and make our lives count for His glory.

MINISTRY FILLED SEPTEMBER!

On the first Sunday of September, we held our very first Family Sunday. We encouraged everyone to invite their families to join us at church so we could spend time in fellowship and get to know one another better. After the service, we shared a meal together and it truly a blessing!

Then, on September 13, we witnessed another answered prayer! As many of you know, we had been praying to begin a ministry for the children we've been teaching on the streets—and by God's grace, we officially launched our Children's Feeding Ministry that day. Amen!

We were able to bring 33 precious children to our church, where we sang songs, shared a meal, and most importantly, shared the Gospel with them. What a joy it was to tell these little ones just how much Jesus loves them! Our prayer is that many of them will come to know Christ as their personal Lord and Savior.

It truly touched my heart to minister to them—especially as I was reminded that not too long ago, I was just like them. We had a wonderful time of fellowship, and it was a blessing in every way!

Looking ahead, on September 28, we will be holding our first Evangelistic Sunday. Please join us in prayer for this special event. We are encouraging everyone to invite their families, friends, neighbors, classmates, and co-workers. Our prayer is that many would hear the gospel and come to know Christ as their Lord and Savior. Following the service, we'll be sharing a simple lunch together, and in the afternoon, as a church, we'll go out into the community to distribute gospel tracts and share the Good News. Please continue to lift us up in your prayers—may the Lord be glorified in all we do!
